

River City Players Scholarship Student Application Procedures

ELIGIBILITY: Any high school senior or graduate attending college, having participated in a minimum of two River City Players productions, is eligible to receive the scholarship for a maximum of two years.

SELECTION OF WINNERS: Winner(s) of the River City Players Scholarship will be selected by a committee chosen by the River City Players Management Team. The winner(s) will be chosen on the basis of character, extra-curricular activities, academic performance and other accomplishments that ensure future success.

ELIGIBLE INSTITUTIONS: River City Players Scholarships may be used at any accredited college, university or technical college offering an Associate's and/or Bachelor's degree.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS: Amounts awarded will be determined by the River City Players Management Team. Checks will be made payable to the designated institution. In the event the recipient fails to enroll after being selected to receive the scholarship award or withdraws before the scholarship is paid, he/she will forfeit any rights to the award.

REQUIRED INFORMATION:

1. Transcript of all past academic work.
2. A recent photograph for publicity purposes.
3. Completed application form.
